EDUCATORS	Expected to follow a developmentally appropriate research-based curriculum
HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS	Trained in administration of medication (currently optional)
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL	Administer First Aid and CPR; design and implement evacuation procedures
SOCIAL WORKERS	Mandated reporters, meaning they are required to report observed or suspected abuse
BUSINESS MANAGERS	Carry out the day-to-day operations
Entrepreneurs	Key decision-maker/Strategist
