

## THE MANY HATS OF A CHILD CARE PROVIDER

<b>CAREGIVERS</b>	Provide help and protection
<b>CHEFS/NUTRITIONISTS</b>	Prepare meals according to department of health standards
<b>HOUSEKEEPERS</b>	Trained in proper hygiene and sanitation
<b>CHILD DEVELOPMENT SPECIALISTS</b>	Knowledgeable in typical and atypical development; can recognize the symptoms of a developmental issue
<b>EDUCATORS</b>	Expected to follow a developmentally appropriate research-based curriculum
<b>HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS</b>	Trained in administration of medication (currently optional)
<b>EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL</b>	Administer First Aid and CPR; design and implement evacuation procedures
<b>SOCIAL WORKERS</b>	Mandated reporters, meaning they are required to report observed or suspected abuse
<b>BUSINESS MANAGERS</b>	Carry out the day-to-day operations
<b>ENTREPRENEURS</b>	Key decision-maker/Strategist
