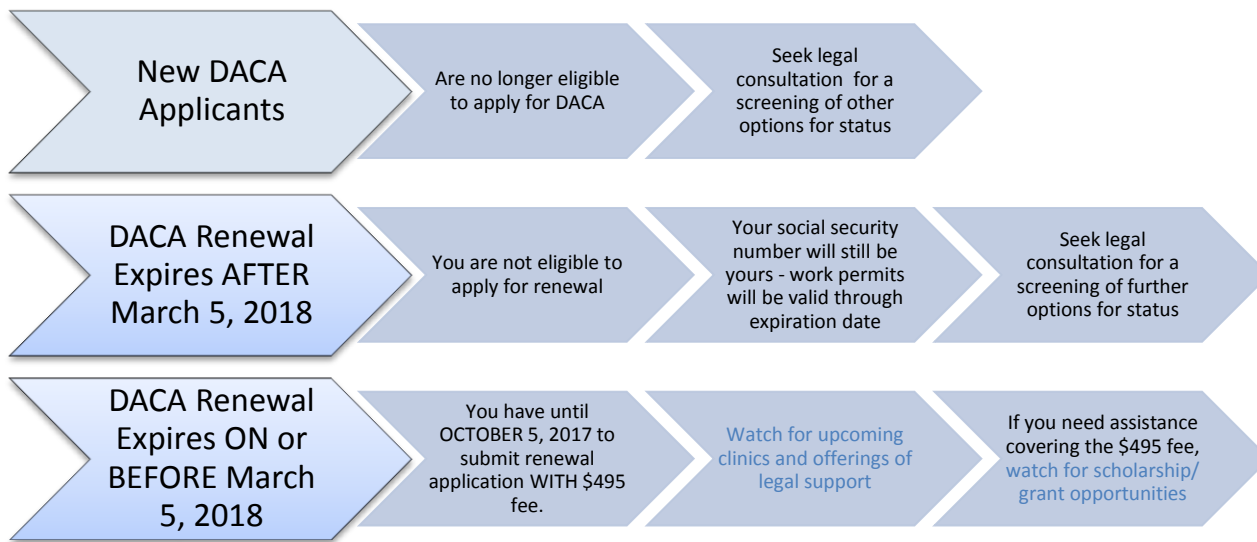

The estimated number of DACAdmented individuals who will need to submit their renewal application before October 5th, with the \$495 fee.

**5,133**

The number of renewal applications that will need to be completed and submitted each day before the October 5th deadline.

**214**

The number of renewal applications that will need to be completed and submitted each hour, if legal representatives work 24/7.
